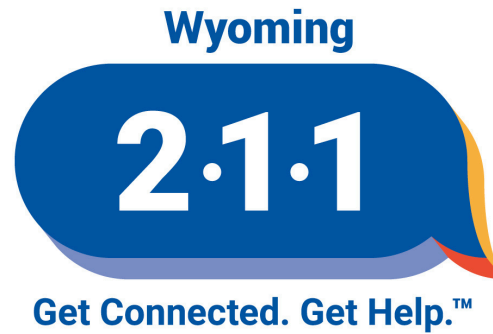


Wyoming 211 has information on programs and services that provide assistance to active duty service members, National Guard and Reserves, veterans and their loved one.
